Volunteer training dates set at new Museum site

Interested in volunteering at the new Sioux City Public Museum site downtown? Two-hour volunteer orientation sessions are set to begin in late March on a variety of dates and times. Prospective volunteers are asked to call the Sioux City Public Museum at 279-6174 by March 18 to sign up.

Among the volunteer positions available are greeters, gallery guides, and assistants with children’s programs, archives, oral histories, or special events. More advanced training for specific volunteer duties will be offered in preparation for the Museum’s grand opening in April.

“Volunteers will be vital in the operations of the expanded Museum facility,” said Weaver-Basye. “We have been extremely pleased with the response so far.”

The new Museum will allow visitors to experience Sioux City history through large, dynamic exhibits and hands-on activities. Among the must-see attractions will be a rare 1918 fire truck and a suspended 1931 Kari Keen airplane.

In addition, the Museum’s archives and research facility is now on-site, housing its collection of 50,000 artifacts and over 250,000 photographs.

The volunteer training will be held at the Sioux City Public Museum’s new site at 607 Fourth Street.
