## **Antique & Classic Car Show marks its 40<sup>th</sup> year**

What started in 1970 as a temporary exhibit at the Sioux City Public Museum has grown into an annual event on Sioux City's riverfront. This year's **Bill Diamond Antique & Classic Car Show** marks the 40<sup>th</sup> year of the event on Saturday, September 5. The car show is typically held on the second weekend in July, but had to be postponed due to rain.

Approximately 75 antique and classic vehicles will be on display from noon to 4 p.m. on the grounds of the Sergeant Floyd River Museum and Welcome Center, 1000 Larsen Park Road. The event is free and open to the public.

The 1970 car show proved to be so popular that the Sioux City Museum and Historical Association continued the event and eventually moved it down to its current location on the riverfront. The car show was renamed in 2004 to honor the event's co-founder and long-time director of the Sioux City Public Museum, Bill Diamond.

The car show will once again feature the Dixieland-style music of the Dixie Daddys throughout the afternoon. Concessions will be available to raise funds for the Museum and Historical Association.

Those wishing to show a classic or antique vehicle should arrive by 11:30 a.m. for placement. This is a Show and Shine event, pre-registration is not required.
