Antique & Classic Car Show returns to the riverfront

Approximately 60 antique and classic vehicles will be on display at the Sioux City Museum and Historical Association's 41st annual **Bill Diamond Antique & Classic Car Show** on Saturday, September 4 from noon to 4 p.m. on the grounds of the Sergeant Floyd River Museum and Welcome Center, 1000 Larsen Park Road. The event is free and open to the public.

The Dixie Daddys will perform their Dixieland-style music throughout the afternoon. Concessions from the House of Q will be available.

Those wishing to show a classic or antique vehicle should arrive by 11:30 a.m. for placement. This is a Show and Shine event, pre-registration is not required.

The Museum & Historical Association renamed the car show in 2004 to honor the event's co-founder and long-time director of the Sioux City Public Museum, Bill Diamond. The car show was started in 1970 at the Sioux City Public Museum site as part of a temporary exhibition. The event proved to be so popular that it was continued and eventually moved down to its current location on the riverfront.
