### **Local preservationist named to Terrace Hill Society Board**

Jim Jung of Sioux City has been elected to the Terrace Hill Society Board of Directors for a three-year term. The Terrace Hill Society is committed to providing volunteer services and raising funds from private sources to protect the historic integrity of Terrace Hill, the residence of the Iowa Governor. In addition, the society allocates funds for the restoration, conservation and preservation of furnishings, decorating and landscaping projects.

The 35-member board is composed of residents from around the state of Iowa. Each board member serves on various committees related to the preservation of the house. Jung has been nominated to the Curatorial and Exhibits Committees of the Society. Jung is a long-time Terrace Hill supporter and was instrumental in arranging the First Lady of Iowa's visit to the Sioux City Public Museum to sign copies of her "Entertaining at Terrace Hill" cookbook to benefit the Victorian-style home.

"This is a great opportunity for Sioux City to be represented in Des Moines in a noteworthy project," said Jung.

Along with his position on the Terrace Hill Society board, Jung is a member of the City of Sioux City's Historic Preservation Commission and coordinates the Sioux City Museum and Historical Association's landscaping at the historic John Peirce Mansion. In the past, he has served as vice president of the Museum and Historical Association's Board of Directors and chaired the Historic Preservation Week Committee.
